

How to Clean Products and Precautions

• To clean decorative melamine boards, coated surfaces, plated surfaces, or resin (nylon/plastic) parts, disinfect by means of any of the following antiseptic solutions, immediately wipe off the solution with a well-squeezed moistened cloth ensuring no solution remains on the surface, lastly wipe the surface dry with a dry soft cloth.

When wiping, do not strongly rub the surface.

- Ethanol for disinfection (concentration: 80%)
- Sodium hypochlorite (concentration: 0.05%)
- Surfactant
- Hypochlorous acid water (weak acid)

Note that on surface material subject to penetration of liquid, such as cloth (fabric), wood, and leather, uneven coloring and discoloration may occur even after cleaning by the above method.

When using an antiseptic solution, we recommend that you first test the solution on an inconspicuous part of the product to establish whether any abnormality occurs.

Depending on the type of antiseptic solution, its residue may cause skin irritation on the person who uses the product.

- For using antiseptic solution on alcohol resistant leathers and sodium hypochlorite resistant leather surfaces, only adopt suitable solution as recommended by and after adequately consulting with the pharmaceutical company which manufactured the antiseptic solution.
- On polished aluminum parts, do not use surfactants by the above method.
